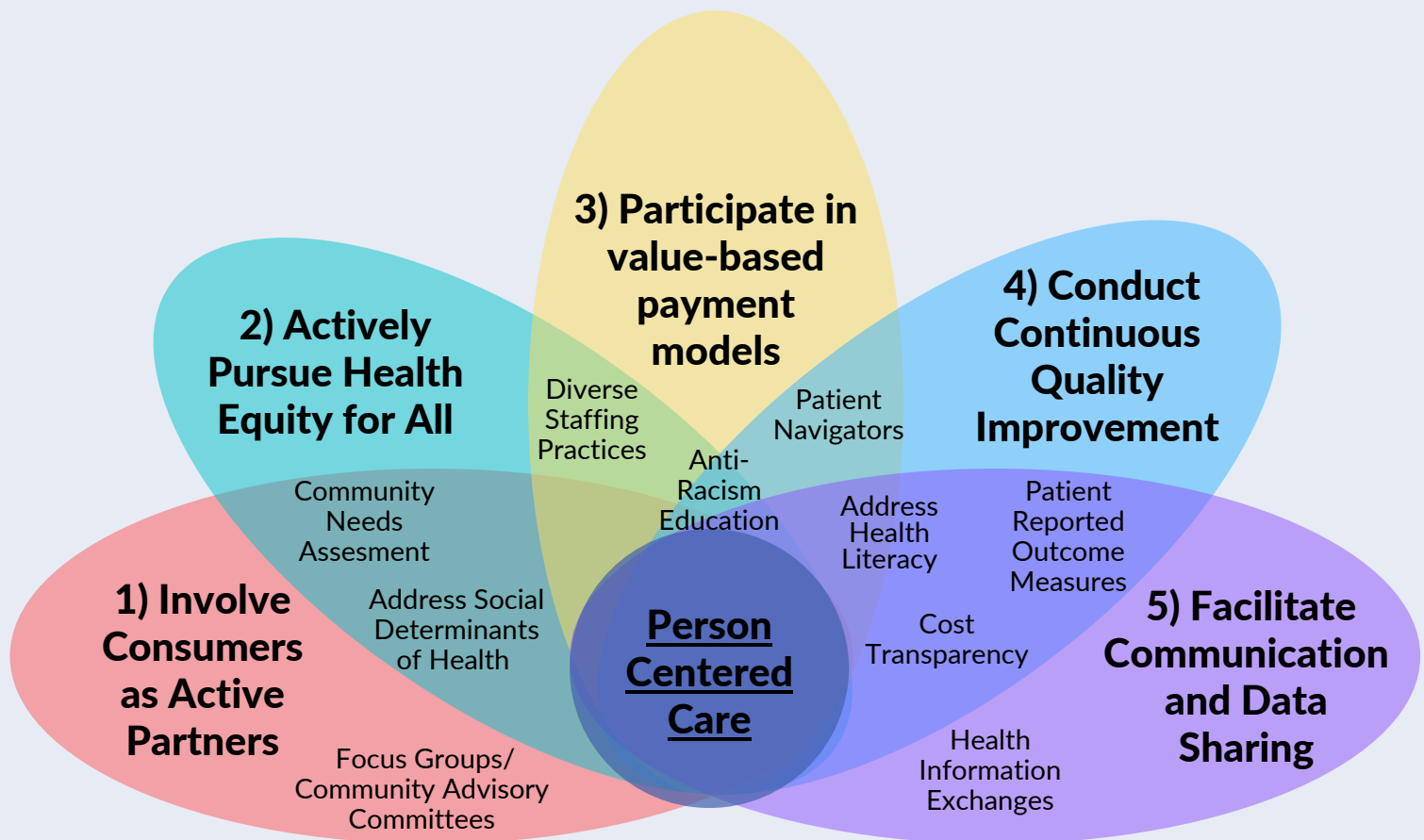


Stories from the Field: Implementing Principles of Person-Centered Care

Universal Actions to Implement Person-Centered Care

- Establish the team, roles, accountability, and feasible timeline
- Standardize demographic data collection, stratification, and analysis practices
- Incorporate patient voices into policies, programs, and quality improvement
- Perform outreach and engagement with community based organizations
